

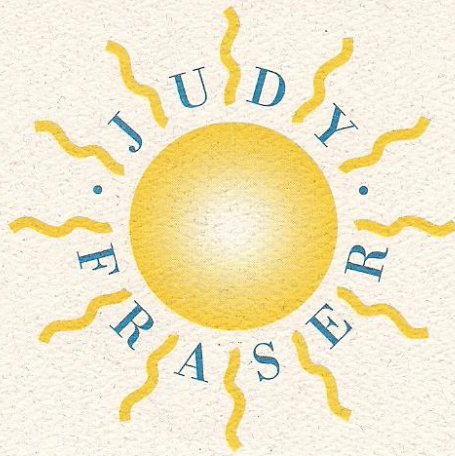
*Dear Chad:*
